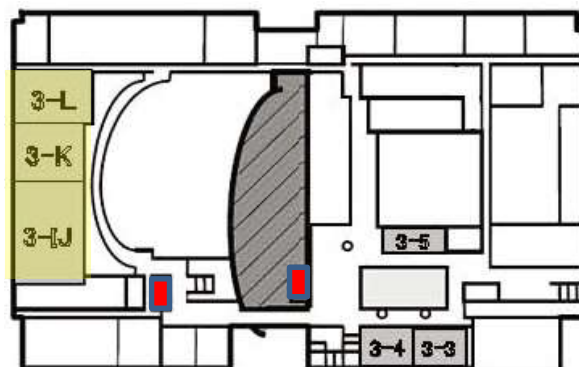

Floor Map

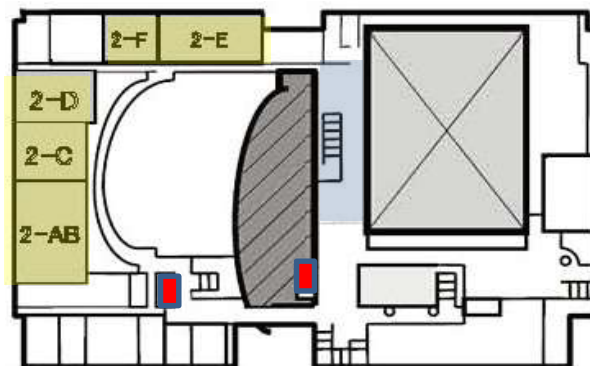

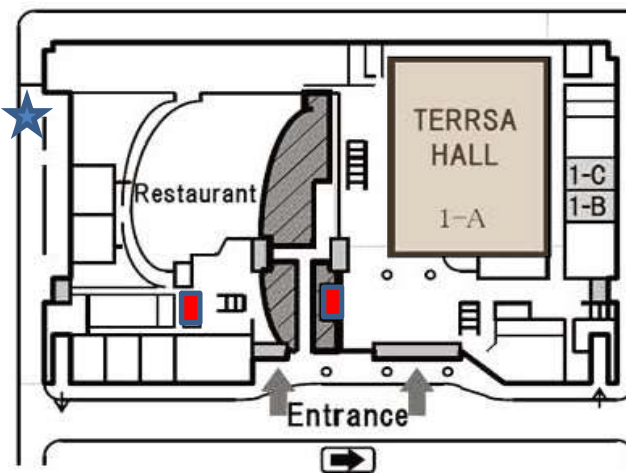
